

## Your Guide to Baroona Sport Horses School Camps

Just one hour's drive from Sydney CBD, Baroona Sport Horses (BSH) boasts first class facilities on a magnificent 50-acre purpose built equestrian facility. With ample paddocks and stables, tack room, wash bays, tie ups, BSH also has an Indoor arena with Ramos fibre surface and mirrors, meaning that you can enjoy your horse rain, hail, or shine.

During our camps, you will be tutored on various parts of equestrian riding and pushed safely outside your comfort zone to make you a more complete rider. Accommodation is situated in our main house on the property with a comfortable, safe, bunk room set-up to suit all needs. Shaun and his team aim to pass on a wealth of experience and knowledge to the discerning equestrians of the future in a fun filled, supportive learning environment.

### Rider Requirements:

- All riding equipment - Riding boots, vest protector, helmet, gloves etc
- Gum boots or another pair of short boots to wear when you are not riding.
- Clothing - riding clothes that suit your needs plus clothes that are suitable for wearing around the property when you not riding. Please check the weather forecast for the time of your stay and bring the appropriate clothing and footwear – stay warm in the winter months and cool in the summer!
- Mobile phone chargers, ear phones, or headsets
- Dietary requirements - please inform us prior to arrival of any specific dietary needs or any allergies by emailing [shaun@baroonasporhorses.com.au](mailto:shaun@baroonasporhorses.com.au) prior to camp
- All meals will be provided, however feel free to bring your own snacks
- Bedding & Bathroom needs - please bring a sleeping bag, extra blanket, and pillow/s as well as your personal toiletries
- Swimmers or shorts & T-shirt will be required for 7-mile beach activities; however, this will be dependent on the weather. Alternative program will be provided
- Cross country training @ Silver Hills is dependent on course availability
- If you are bringing your own horse please bring feed & rugs
- Please note - daily programs are subject to change depending on the season and weather conditions on the day. Safety of our students & horses is our top priority
- Parents or guardians are required to sign children in on drop off day and then sign them out on pick up day. Should a different person be nominated to collect and sign for your child, prior arrangements must be made with admin
- Unannounced drop-ins during the week are not permitted – please contact admin

## Daily Program for 5 Day School Camp

**Monday** Drop off arrival time is **10am** sharp

Midmorning - Trail ride: A relaxing trail ride down through the beautiful valleys of BSH.

Afternoon - Flatwork - Poles & Jumping.

Yard duties: Wash-down horses, feeding and rugging.

### **Tuesday**

Midmorning - Horse camp activities day

Afternoon - Jumping course: Straightness & Accuracy – leading into 60cm -1m jumping.

Yard duties: Wash-down horses, feeding and rugging.

Evening - Campfire Night BBQ

### **Wednesday**

Morning - Cross country training off site at Silver Hills

Afternoon - Trail ride

Yard duties: Wash-down horses, feeding and rugging.

### **Thursday**

All day adventure! Horse riding @ 7-mile beach. Please note that this activity will be dependent on the weather. Our alternate program will be show jumping courses and protocol dressage tests.

Yard duties: Wash-down horses, feeding and rugging.

### **Friday**

Morning - Mini Gymkhana - healthy competition for the enthusiastic rider!

Afternoon - Mini Gymkhana - a bit of fun and excitement to finish of the camp!

Yard duties: Prepare horses for transporting home - wash-down, grooming etc.

Pick up time is **4pm**.

### **Your Investment:**

\$975 per person with own horse or \$1100 per person with Baroona educated horse. All fees are payable in advance to camp starting date. Payment plans are also available with a non-refundable \$200 holding deposit.
